Day 1 - Bishkek

Welcome to Bishkek, the dynamic capital of Kyrgyzstan! Upon your arrival, our team will meet you at the airport and transfer you to your hotel. Once you've checked in and settled, the remainder of the day is yours to relax after your journey or explore the city's lively streets and serene parks at your own pace. Overnight in Bishkek. (Dinner)

Day 2 - Bishkek / Burana Tower / Chon Kemin National Park

After a relaxed breakfast, we'll begin a guided exploration of Bishkek, delving into its vibrant history and unique Soviet-era charm. Highlights of the tour include Ala-Too Square, the heart of the city, the Monument of Manas, dedicated to the legendary hero, the serene Oak Park, and Victory Square, a tribute to World War II heroes. In the afternoon, we'll depart for the scenic Chon Kemin Valley, stopping en route to visit the Burana Tower, an intriguing relic of the ancient Silk Road. This historic minaret, surrounded by remnants of a medieval city, offers a glimpse into the region's fascinating past. Upon arriving in Chon Kemin, you'll settle into a cozy guesthouse nestled amidst beautiful natural surroundings. Enjoy a tranquil evening to relax and prepare for the next leg of your adventure. Overnight in Chon Kemin. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 3 - Chon Kemin / Bokonbaevo

Begin your day with a morning hike in the Chon Kemin Valley, where the serene landscapes and towering mountains provide breathtaking views at every turn. Alternatively, you may choose to explore the nearby gorges or take part in local cultural experiences such as horseback riding or learning the traditional art of yurt construction. Later, we'll head towards the stunning Lake Issyk-Kul, one of the largest alpine lakes in the world. As we approach, the vast expanse of its shimmering waters set against the backdrop of majestic mountains will leave you spellbound. On the way, we'll stop at Kyzyl Tuu village, famed for its traditional yurt-making craftsmanship, where you can learn about this age-old skill. Our journey continues to Bokonbaevo, where you'll meet an eagle hunter and witness the ancient art of falconry, a tradition passed down through generations of nomadic families. The day ends with an overnight stay in Bokonbaevo, where the charm of Kyrgyzstan's nomadic lifestyle creates a truly unforgettable experience.

Day 4 - Bokonbaevo / Skazka Canyon / Djety Oguz Canyon / Karakol

Journey along the scenic shores of Lake Issyk-Kul to the spectacular Fairy Tale (Skazka) Canyon, known for its vibrant, otherworldly rock formations. Continue to the dramatic Djety Oguz Canyon, famed for its red cliffs, including the iconic "Broken Heart" rock and "Seven Bulls" formations. Arrive in Karakol, a town rich in history and culture. Visit the Dungan Mosque, the Russian Orthodox Holy Trinity Cathedral, and the N. M. Przhevalsky Museum, dedicated to the renowned Russian explorer. Overnight in Karakol. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 5 - Karakol / Border Crossing / Kolsai Lakes / Saty

We'll cross the border into Kazakhstan and make our way to Saty Village, a charming settlement within the breathtaking Kolsai Lakes National Park. Here, we'll have the chance to explore the stunning surroundings, including a hike to the tranquil Kolsai Lakes, often called the "Blue Necklace" of the Tien Shan Mountains for their striking beauty. If time allows, we'll also visit Kaindy Lake, famous for its submerged forest and crystal-clear turquoise waters that create an almost surreal landscape. After a day of exploration, we'll settle into Saty Village for an overnight stay. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 6 - Saty / Charyn Canyon / Almaty

After breakfast, we'll begin our journey to Almaty, with an unforgettable stop at the stunning Charyn Canyon. Here, we'll explore the Valley of Castles, a breathtaking section of the canyon known for its dramatic rock formations and sweeping panoramic views, showcasing nature's incredible artistry. After soaking in the beauty of this natural wonder, we'll continue our drive to Almaty, Kazakhstan's vibrant and largest city. Upon arrival, we'll check into the hotel, where you'll have the evening to relax and unwind after a day of exploration and adventure. Overnight in Almaty. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 7 - Almaty

Your day in Almaty starts with a visit to Panfilov Park, where you'll discover the story of the 28 heroes who sacrificed their lives for the nation's freedom. Take in the beauty of Zenkov Cathedral, the oldest wooden building in the city, and pay your respects at the Memorial Complex, which features an eternal flame. Continue your journey with a visit to the lively Green Bazaar for local souvenirs, then explore the central Mosque and stop at Republic Square to admire the Independence Obelisk and other national monuments. In the afternoon, make your way up to Kok-Tobe Hill for sweeping views of Almaty, followed by a walk through Kok-Tobe Park, where you'll find a monument dedicated to "The Beatles." Conclude your day with a scenic cable car ride back to the city center before returning to your hotel. Overnight in Almaty. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 8 - Almaty / Dushanbe

In the morning, transfer to the airport for a brief flight (around 1 hour 40 minutes) to Dushanbe, the capital of Tajikistan. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy a leisurely evening to unwind or explore the peaceful ambiance of the city at your own pace. Overnight in Dushanbe. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 9 - Dushanbe

Discover the vibrant charm of Dushanbe on a guided city tour, beginning with a visit to the impressive Navruz Palace, a remarkable example of modern Tajik architecture. Stroll through the bustling local markets, where the sights, sounds, and vibrant colors of traditional Tajik life are on full display as you explore local handicrafts and fresh produce. Next, unwind in the serene atmosphere of Rudaki Park, a lush green haven dedicated to the renowned Persian poet Rudaki. Overnight in Dushanbe. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 10 - Dushanbe / Iskanderkul / Penjikent

Today, we'll embark on a scenic drive from Dushanbe to Penjikent, a charming town located at the foot of the Fann Mountains. As we travel through Tajikistan's spectacular landscape, you'll be captivated by the breathtaking views of winding rivers and jagged peaks. If the group is interested, we can take a brief detour to Iskanderkul Lake, named after Alexander the Great. Surrounded by majestic mountains, this peaceful alpine lake is the perfect spot for a short break and some stunning photographs. Afterward, we'll resume our journey to Penjikent, where we'll settle in for the night. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 11 - Penjikent / Seven Lakes / Penjikent

Today, we'll spend the day exploring the Seven Lakes, a stunning chain of alpine lakes tucked away in the Fann Mountains. Each lake, with its distinctive hue and dramatic mountain backdrop, offers breathtaking views and plenty of opportunities for photography. You'll embark on a day of hiking through the scenic landscapes, immersing yourself in nature as we pass through lush valleys and untouched terrain. After taking in the natural beauty of the lakes, we'll return to Penjikent for the night. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 12 - Penjikent / Sarazm / Border Crossing / Samarkand

Today, we'll cross into Uzbekistan and make our way to the legendary city of Samarkand, one of the most iconic destinations along the Silk Road. On our journey, we'll stop at Sarazm, an ancient archaeological site and UNESCO World Heritage Site, where you'll have the chance to explore the remains of one of Central Asia's earliest urban settlements, dating back to the early Bronze Age. After our visit to Sarazm, we'll continue on to Samarkand. Upon arrival, we'll begin our city tour, which includes the awe-inspiring Registan Square, the grand Bibi-Khanym Mosque, and the stunning Shah-i-Zinda necropolis, a collection of exquisite mausoleums. Overnight in Samarkand. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 13 - Samarkand / Bukhara

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll transfer you to the train station for your high-speed journey from Samarkand to Bukhara on the "Afrosiab" train, which takes just an hour and a half. Upon arrival in Bukhara, we'll take you to your hotel to check in and unwind. Your guided tour of Bukhara will begin with a visit to the historic Lyabi-Khauz complex, home to Central Asia's oldest pool, surrounded by stunning medieval buildings such as the Nadira Divan-begi madrasah and Khanaka, both renowned for their intricate mosaic facades. You'll also explore the Kukeldash madrasah, the largest in Bukhara. Later, we'll visit the remarkable Poi-Kalyan Complex, which houses the iconic Kalyan Minaret, the Kalyan Friday Mosque, and the active Miri-Arab madrasah, each showcasing the rich architectural legacy of Bukhara. Overnight in Bukhara. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 14 - Bukhara

The next day, meet your guide in the hotel lobby to continue your sightseeing in Bukhara. Start by visiting the historic Samanids Mausoleum, one of the oldest and most cherished landmarks in the city. Then, explore the Ark Citadel, the former residence of the Emir for many centuries, offering stunning views of Bukhara. Afterward, head to the distinctive Chor-Minor, a striking structure with four minarets. Finally, visit the exquisite Sitorai-Mohi-Khosa Palace, the summer retreat of the Bukhara Emirs, set amidst serene gardens. Overnight in Bukhara. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 15 - Bukhara / Border Crossing / Mary

Start your day with free time to explore the captivating city of Bukhara at your own pace. Take a leisurely stroll through its historic streets, revisit your favorite landmarks, or unwind in one of its peaceful courtyards before we depart for Mary in Turkmenistan. Upon arrival in Mary, enjoy an introductory tour that includes visits to the History Museum of the Mary Region, the Russian Orthodox Church, the vibrant local bazaar, and the impressive Gurbanguly Haji Mosque, a striking example of modern Turkmen architecture. After the tour, transfer to your hotel to check in and relax. Overnight in Mary. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 16 - Mary / Merv / Ashgabat

After breakfast, head out to the Ancient City of Merv, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most significant cities along the historic Silk Road. Explore the vast historical park, which includes the impressive Sultan Sanjar Mausoleum, the Large and Small Gyz Gala, Erk Gala, Gyaurla Gala, the Keshk Fortresses, the Muhammed ibn Zaid Mausoleum, and other remarkable landmarks that highlight the city's rich past. After experiencing Merv's fascinating history, return to Mary for a short flight (approximately 40 minutes) to Ashgabat, the modern capital of Turkmenistan. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel and unwind for the evening. Overnight in Ashgabat. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 17 - Ashgabat / Nissa / Ashgabat

After breakfast, we'll embark on a full-day city tour of Ashgabat, exploring the city's most iconic landmarks. Our journey begins at the National Museum, where we'll dive into the rich history and culture of Turkmenistan. Next, we'll visit Independence Park, home to grand monuments that symbolize the nation's sovereignty, followed by the Rukhnama Monument and the impressive Neutrality Arch. We'll then take a ride on the Ferris Wheel, offering panoramic views of the city, and stop at the Magtymguly Monument, dedicated to the revered Turkmen poet. A highlight of the day will be visiting the ancient ruins of Nissa, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with fascinating remnants of Parthian architecture. We'll conclude our tour with a visit to the magnificent Turkmenbashi Mosque-Mausoleum, a stunning fusion of spirituality and artistry. After a day of exploration, we'll transfer back to the hotel for an overnight stay. Overnight in Ashgabat. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 18 - Ashgabat / Dashoguz

After breakfast, we'll continue exploring the highlights of Ashgabat, a city renowned for its striking combination of modernity and tradition. Our day begins with a visit to the Ahalteke horse stables, where you'll learn about Turkmenistan's prized horses. We'll then stop at the stunning Ertogrul Ghazi Mosque before visiting the historic Lenin Monument and experiencing the vibrant atmosphere of the Russian Bazaar. Next, we'll explore the poignant Earthquake Monument and the Soviet War Memorial Complex, both of which commemorate important events in Turkmenistan's history. The day wraps up with a tour of the Carpet Museum, showcasing the intricate artistry of Turkmen carpets, followed by a visit to the Wedding Palace viewpoint for breathtaking panoramic views of the city. In the evening, we'll transfer to the airport for a flight (approximately 50 minutes) to Dashoguz. Upon arrival, you'll be met and transferred to your hotel for an overnight stay. Overnight in Dashoguz. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 19 - Dashoguz / Kunya Urgench / Khiva

In the morning, we'll drive to Kunya Urgench, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Turkmenistan's most important historical landmarks. Here, we'll explore the fascinating historical park, featuring the towering Kutlug Timur Minaret, the beautiful Mausoleum of Turabek Khanum, the Mausoleum of Tekesh, the Mausoleum of Il Arslan, and the Caravansaray Gateway, among other

notable sites. Afterward, we'll head to Dashoguz for lunch and visit the History Museum of the Dashoguz Region, the Central Mosque, and the vibrant local bazaar. In the afternoon, we'll cross the border into Uzbekistan and drive to Khiva, a well-preserved Silk Road city rich in history and charm. Upon arrival, we'll check into our hotel for an overnight stay. Overnight in Khiva. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 20 - Khiva

Meet your guide in the hotel lobby for a Khiva sightseeing tour, where you'll discover the wonders of Ichan Kala, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Begin with the Kalta-Minor Minaret, a striking yet unfinished structure standing 26 meters tall with a base diameter of 16 meters. It was originally intended to be the tallest minaret in Central Asia. Next, visit Kunya-Ark, the first palace of Khiva's khans, and the Pahlovan Mahmud Mausoleum, an exquisite example of Islamic architecture. Continue to the Islam Khodja Madrassah and Minaret, completed in 1908, before visiting the unique Juma Mosque, renowned for its flat roof supported by 218 intricately carved wooden columns that provide exceptional acoustics. These historical and architectural treasures will offer you a deep understanding of Khiva's rich heritage. Overnight in Khiva. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 21 - Khiva / Tashkent

After breakfast, we'll transfer to the airport for a short flight to Tashkent, which takes approximately 1 hour and 20 minutes. Upon arrival, we'll take you to your hotel, where you'll have the rest of the day free to relax, explore the city at your leisure, or unwind before the next adventure. Overnight in Tashkent. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 22 - Tashkent

Today, we'll immerse ourselves in the rich history and vibrant culture of Tashkent. Our day begins with a visit to the historic Old Town and the Khast-Imam Architectural Complex, home to the revered Osman Quran. We'll then head to Amir Timur Square, dedicated to the legendary conqueror, and visit the Courage Monument, which honors the resilience of Tashkent's people. Next, we'll admire the grandeur of the Opera and Ballet Theater and take a leisurely stroll through Mustaqillik (Independence) Square, where modern landmarks celebrate Uzbekistan's independence. The day continues with a visit to the bustling "Chorsu" Eastern Bazaar, a lively market filled with local crafts, spices, textiles, and traditional Uzbek artistry. This tour offers a perfect blend of old and new, highlighting the cultural, historical, and architectural treasures that make Tashkent a truly unique destination. Overnight in Tashkent. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 23 - Tashkent

After breakfast, we'll transfer you to the airport for your flight home, bringing an end to your unforgettable journey through Central Asia. Safe travels, and we look forward to welcoming you on another adventure in the future! (Breakfast)

INFORMATION ABOUT VISAS

Go Russia provides assistance in processing visas and visa fees are included in the cost of most of our trips as detailed in the tour dossier. The visa application process is very straightforward. We have years of practical experience in dealing with tourist visas, and our in-house visa team provides assistance with completing the forms and checking the documents before consular submission. Please do not worry that your application will be unsuccessful (unless you have had any immigration issues with the relevant authorities in the past). All our tourists get their visas.

All nationalities require a full passport valid for at least six months beyond the intended length of stay. Please also make sure there are enough blank pages in your passport: Russian consulate requires minimum two blank pages.

USA, UK, Germany, France, Spain residents

We have in-house visa teams in the US, UK, Germany, France and Spain. Upon your booking we will email you detailed guidance notes how to fill in the visa forms and what additional documents depending on nationality and your immigration status will be required. You will need to post your application pack to our visa processing office including your original passport. Please allow about two weeks for each visa application to be processed. Please advise us if you require your passport urgently, we can arrange urgent processing for an additional charge.

Non-USA, UK, Germany, France, Spain residents

If you are not resident in the USA, UK, Germany, France or Spain, we will issue official paperwork and email the required documents to you. You will need to apply for your visa at the local consulate. The process is very straightforward and we can assist you with completing the visa forms. You will have to pay the correct visa fee at the consulate in the country of your residence.
